

Due to lack of certain certificates among poor citizens they find difficulties to access government schemes therefore Janshayog team intervened on government departments system to deliver certificates or schemes timely. This activity has been started during 2005 in respond to the vulnerable groups in our society. During 2014-15 we help 3270 beneficiaries to access the government schemes. Consistent Follow-up of remaining applications is going on.

Circumstances compelled our Jansahayog team to pressurize the concerned culprits by organizing various public demonstrations, Satyagraha and Gherao, before the office of Thashildar. In the reporting year too we submitted 19 memorandums to Government's Authority to respond the need of the people. We visited 179 times to Government Offices for Advocacy on the same cause.

Domestic Worker's Association: Jansahayag formed an association for Domestic workers called "Domestic Worker's Association" to overcome their difficulties by sharing and voice-out. Till date they are guided by our Jansahayog team. The 7th annual day of Association of Domestic workers was arranged. They were addressed by Mr. Rajkumar Ghayal, labour leader, Beed and Dr. Jostna Chate from Kunkulol Hospital, Ambajogai. On this occasion Dr. Dwarkadas Lohiya (Babuji), Datta Ambekar Journalist, Mr. Aniket Lohiya, Mr. Lalasaheb Agle, the staff of Manavlok and college of Social work were



attended. Mr. Datta Ambekar (Journalist) extended a donation of Rs. 3000/- for refreshment. Presently Jansahayog is very popular center of Manavlok which works on advocacy for the poor and ignorant people.

Health Department

National tuberculosis Eradication Programme (DOT): This programme is implementing since 2003. Since inception of the project there is 385 TB Patients as benefited beneficiaries under this programme. In the Current reporting year 5 TB Patients have Course Completed and Recovered, and 4 TB patients are still going on the courses. We also conducted 41 Meetings cum Awareness in 41 villages, Rally, Role Play, and Poster Exhibitions.

CBM (Community Based Monitoring):

Manavlok has been selected as District Coordination Organization and Taluka Organization of Ambajogai Taluka's for CBM. This activity is being implemented in 35 villages of Ambajogai Taluka. Under this project we had organized several meetings, workshop, training, awareness for different categories. Presently this project is covering 5- PHCs (Apegaon, Bardapur, Bhavthana, Ujani, Ghatnandur), one Rural Hospital(Dhanora), Block Hospital (Ambajogai), and District Hospital(Beed).

District Monitoring and Planning Committee were arranged and different problems regarding health services were put before higher authorities of Ambajogai and Beed District. A workshop was organized for different organizations and staffs of health department. Workshop was arranged for people's representatives, five meetings were conducted with the workers of Taluka co-ordination NGO's for review of activities and planning. A training and awareness programme were conducted for patient's welfare committee. Nutrition and water supply committees were extended and the training was given to them. Progress report of four primary health centers were prepared and displayed in the respective primary health centers. Similarly a progress report of rural hospital located at Dhanora village was prepared and displayed on the walls of hospital.

We organized several Public Hearing on social issues at different places. Several villagers have discussed on the issues of health services in the presence of district medical health 'Sabhapati', and district medical officer.

Some of the problems were solved immediately. Second public hearing was held in civil hospital, Mandi Bazar Ambajogai for different problems. For this programme 460 people were present including MLA shree Prithviraj Sathe. Others Public hearing programme was arranged in Apegaon, Bhavthanam, Bardapur, Ghatnandur primary health centers under Ambajogai Taluka. About 579 villagers took part in these



programmes. A follow up was done by visiting villages, visiting higher authorities and through postal communication regarding the health issues.

In the primary health centers of Apegaon, Bardapur and Bhavthana, there were recorded ascending in the OPD and other services after public hearing were done. The nebulizers and Ambulances that were started effectively using. The meetings of patient welfare committees had started held regularly along with the active participation of people's representative at increasing scale. The quality of health services has been improved as per evaluation report. Awareness on services to be given by PHC has been developed. Installed a complaint box at Panchayat Samiti Office to get peoples' opinion about health issues and these complaints has been discussed by BDO (Block Development Officer, Ambajogai), public elected members, organization Representatives.

Asha Sanghatna meetings also conducted every three months regularly. Their problems were put before the authorities. Manavlok provides Ambulance for needy patients on the basis of neither lost nor profit. In the reporting it was used by 7 patients and contributed a sum of Rs. 8060 for maintenance. And using for 2 deferent health camps.

IBP(International Budget Partnership): Study facilities about funds, utilization of health sector. Through this programme we conducted study on the grants and utilization of 4 PHCs (Apegaon, Bardapur, Bhavthana, Ghatnandur), and a block health office through discussion with District health officer, Reproductive Child Health Officer, and Representatives of SATHI Organisation-Pune.

Jaipur Foot Camps: Camp of Fitting Artificial Limbs

Camps of Fitting Artificial Limbs had been organized at Ambajogai and Salegoan in collaboration with "Sadhu Vasavani, Mission" Pune. The Camps held on 26th and 27th July 2014 were organized at two deferent places for identifying the right beneficiaries and measured the legs and hands of the beneficiaries. Follow-up Camps held on 13th & 14th September 2014 where we fitted the artificial limbs on legs and hand of the beneficiaries. In these particular Camps, 242 beneficiaries were benefited treatment and artificial limbs.

ChildLine

Manavlok is a Nodal Organization of implementing Childline 1098 activities in Beed City. Twelve weekly and three monthly meeting have been conducted with partner's organization " Yuva gram". We did Awareness about Childline activities during Khandeshwari Fair. Children's Day was celebrated on 14th Nov. A protest rally on child labour issue was organized and a poster was published with the slogan "Say No to Child Labour". We had Childline Se Dosti Karo programme by organizing Drawing Competition and Hand-Writing Competition.

A 17 year old girl of rape case was assisted. On this particular case intervention District Collector had given satisfactory comment on our help to the victims and her family members. During his visit, he sanctioned Rs. 300000 (Three lakhs) for the victims. Also we collected Rs. 31,000 from local people as donation and handed over to the victims. Bonded Labor District committee held meeting on this particular case. Dr. Dwarkadas lohiya (Founder of Manavlok and member of it) and district collector Nawlkishor Ram declared the case as bonded labour and issued a certificate of bonded labor to the victim.

Manaswini Mahila Prakalp (MMP)

Manaswini Mahila Prakalp is a Women's wing of Manavlok, runs separately for the cause of violence and discrimination against women since 1984. In the reporting period the undertaken programmes and activities are as follow:

- Free Legal aid & Counseling Centre** – In the reporting year we received 186 cases of violence against women and dispute in the family. 29 cases were compromised and settled. 8 matters were referred to court. We did Follow-up for 88 cases of old and new matter. 4 notices served through Advocate/Lawyer to the accused. We received two cases which is referred by police. Regular visit of our Legal advisor was remarkable. We recorded that Cases are registered from all over Marathwada regions.
- Shelter Home** - In the reporting year, 12 needy women were given shelter in our Dilasa Grauha. They were provided medical as well as legal aid. One child was referred to Snehalaya-Ahmednagar. They were assisted with psychological support and they made aware of the required law to take their own decision.

- c) **Gender Sensitization-** A Campaign for gender equality and protection of women from domestic violence were carried successfully among 20 villages under Ambajogai Tehsil. Community support groups were formed in each village having 8 women and men Member to prevent domestic violence at village level. 14 Workshops for 20 villagers, Essay Writing Competition for High School Students on the Gender Sensitization were held in 6 villages, and Parents' Meetings were conducted. Our team make regular weekly visit to Burn Ward of Government Medical College, Ambajogai.

Education

Run-zhun Kindergarten: In the reporting year we have 33 children in our Kindergarten. We organized Art & Culture Activities for their development. This activity helps the Home Science College students to fulfill the curriculum of their syllabus.



Home Science College for Women: We proposed to SNTD Women's University Bombay which is our affiliated university of our Home Science College for closing new intake of student in our institute. In the reporting year we didn't take any new students and there were 8 students of final year B.Sc Home Science. College celebrated the National Nutrition Week by organizing cooking competition. Final year student adopted one village Morewadi and provided Art & Craft training to women. Students Organized Exhibition of Art & Craft.

Manavlok College of Social Sciences: For MSW course 40 students in first year and 41 students in second year are admitted. Parents meeting organized for introducing the course. Rules and regulations of the college. In college library there are 4315 reference books, periodicals, 12 news papers are available. E library facility is also provided. Books exhibition is organized every year.

Orientation visits were organized. Filed work agency supervisor,s meeting was organized where 14 supervisors attended. Rural camp organized at Kuranwadi. Study tour went to Aurangabad, Paithan and Daulatabad. Dr. Vilas Bet's lecture on challenges for social work become helpful along with that shri Kakasaheb Dole guide students on women related legislation and role of police. Shri Amrut Mahajan and shri Gundale author of book

named 'Andharashi Don Hat' communicated and guided students. Students also participated in survey of suicide family. They made awareness through street play on various issues.

Under the Vasantaoji Kale Education Scheme (Earn & Learn) 4 students were assisted by given Rs. 300 per month. For the duration of 4 months. 11 students participated in central year festival organized at Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University Aurangabad. As per UGC rules students council containing eight students is established. Anti Ragging committee, committee on anti sexual harassment of women. IQAC, social justice and empowerment committee have also established.

NAAC evaluation : as per UGC rules our college evaluated and assessed by NAAC peer team. They shown their satisfaction over number of projects and activities run by college. After three months on 12th May 2015. College received letter from NAAC mentioned 'B' Grade.



Employment and guidance cell of the college organised campus interviews. 10 students got job through it.

National freedom day, Marathwada Mukti Sangram Din, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University Name extension day, world's women day etc. were celebrated in

the college. Day celebrations on occasion of birth anniversary and memorial day of National leaders like Mahatma Gandhi, Chh. Shivaji Maharaj, Dr. B. R. Ambedkar were celebrated. Mahatma Gandhi Foundation Jalgaon and our college jointly organized Gandhi Vichan Sanskar Exam where 78 students participated.

Course Work on Research Methodology : 26 research scholars participated in this workshop. Dr. Sansanwal from New Delhi was available as a resource person. Environment activist Shri. Atul Delgaonkar delivered lecture on need of awareness about number of issues. ASER Mumbai and our college togetherly conducted survey on education status in Beed district. 70 students participated in it.



Lek Ladki Abhiyan – Satara in association with college organized campaign for making awareness against female feticide.

Manavlok's Research Bulletin having ISSN quarterly reached in 12 district of Maharashtra. At present it has 42 members. College took participation in cleanliness city campaign and won second prize. Ex students association is established and Pitrusmruti awards are given to students who get excellent merit in university's examination. It is based on the interest of the amount which is honoured to Dr. D. S. Lohiya and Dr. Shaila Lohiya in various felicitation along with that Principal Dr. Prakash Jadhav also honoured students with excellent merit. In this academic year Devendra Samblre got both of Prize Rani Uttam Pawar and Pitrusmruti Awards.

Parivartan Prakalp (Project) Since 7th September 2012 this project is running on the money contribution by teaching and non-teaching staff of the college. SHG's establishment. Awareness making on various issues, women empowerment etc. social work is consistently going on through Parivartan project.

Hostels

It helps the poor rural girls/boys to take the benefits of higher education by providing lodging and boarding at concessional rates. Both Girls and Boys grow and develop their potential in the progressive environment at the hostel which is integrated with other activities of the organization. We separate hostels for boys and girls. Girls' Hostel is located at MMP Campus and Boys' Hostel is Located at Manavlok' Head Office Campus. In the reporting year we admitted 29 girls and 8 boys respectively.



Training Center and Monitoring Related

Our training centre is well designed and well furnished for both residential and non-residential types of trainings, located at Manavlok Campus, Ambajogai. This training centre is one of the sources to build our volunteers to professional social worker and it is a source of income generating through lending to other organization for trainings.



In the reporting year, we used this training centre for various trainings Conducted by Manavlok for the stakeholders of integrated watershed development like A training programme for the committee members of watershed programme under integrated watershed management programme sponsored by Vasundhara Watershed development scheme, and Introductory Training on preparation of detailed project report, training on participatory rural appraisal, training on internal resources and livelihood. Being Manavlok is a District Recourse Organisation (DRO) for integrated watershed management programme; we send the trainings' reports to Yashada, Pune. Shri. Lalasaheb Agale had been to Yashada, Pune for the planning and review of the training given under Manavlok as District Resources Organization. Ku. Deepali Maske had attended twice ten days training programme organized by Krishi Vidnyan Kendra Karpude Jalana.

Also this training centre was used by defferent department of Manavlok like Manavlok's College of Social Sciences used it for conferences and classes for both students and academicians. For income generating we allowed other organizations/people to use our training centre. In the reporting year too there were 7 workshops/programmes and 5 marriages were held in this training centre and Halls.

We had conducted final evaluated the activities of Haryali at several villages like two villages under Tq. Shirur, 6 villages under Tq. Asti, 2 villages under Tq. Patoda, 2 Villages under Tq. Wadavani, two Villages under Tq. Beed, 4 villages under Tq. Kaij.

Skills Training

We provide skill training for women at Salegaon Sub-Center. In the reporting there were 31 beneficiaries under tailoring course. Out of 31 beneficiaries 28 were sponsored MICONE.

Agriculture and Environment Development Project

We are doing not only teaching others for the development of agriculture but we also implement our knowledge practically in our own farm. During Kharip crop season of the current year, we cultivated Soyabean crop during Kharif season. And During Rabbi Season we cultivated gram crop. Our garden also cultivated a Variety of vegetables seasonally. All the activities of our farm had been implemented with new technologies like BBF machine while sowing, Boom Sprayer while weeding, Harvester while harvesting, etc. Also twenty fruit trees were planted at Bhavthana Center, 33 nursery plants planted at Salegaon Center and 20 plants planted at Yelda Center.



Store / Processing / Vehicle

We spent An amount of Rs. 14,02,717 on the purchased of stationary and miscellaneous material. We spent Rs. 41,49,860 on buying the equipments like Tractor, M.B Plough, Cultivator, Rotavator, Broad Bed Furrow (BBF) seed drillers, Boom Sprayer, Harvester, Lesser Land Leveler, TATA Xenon, Trailers, etc. for the project of Farm Mechanization. For administration work we purchased one motor cycle amount to Rs.48200/-. We spent Rs. 780854 on Vehicles' fuel, Vehicles' Parts and Maintenances of the Vehicles.

Rs. 228024/- had been collected as rent from Organisation's vehicles. Scrape materials were sold for Rs. 28,265. 762 toilet units were sold under RSM for Rs. 156275/-. As per the requirement/demand of the villagers we exercised our processing unit of Snehadhara oil mill, Dal mill, Flour mill located at Sub-Center; Salegaon, and we generate Rs. 176745 from the beneficiaries for maintenances.

On this auspicious day thirteen couples got married in the presence of thousands of people. Among these, twelve couples were married in Hindu Custom and one couple was in Muslim Custom.

In this function, both the Bride and Bridegroom were provided all the requirement of marriage ceremony (i.e.



attires and rings, priest, etc) by the organizer. Basic daily requirements of family like utensils, cooking stove with gas cylinder, etc. were gifted to these 13 married couple.

Help of Rs. 5000/- was given to the family of late Mahadev Ashok Shelke who committed suicide due to the crop lost by heavy rain fall and hailstorm. The responsibility of education of his sister was also taken up by Manavlok.

1st Death Anniversary of Dr. Shaila Lohiya

Being Dr. Shiala Lohiya (Wife of Dr. D.S. Lohiya) was the supporting pillar to Dr. D.S. Lohiya in establishing Manavlok. She was also recognised by many organisations for her great dedication and exemplary efforts in the field of social work. She was also a social activist in uplifting the marginalized groups of our society. She represented India to many countries on social issues conferences. Some of these include FICCI Ladies Association's National Award (Delhi), Elizabeth Wilson Award by Sadhana Trust-Pune, "Punyashiok Ahilyabai Holkar Award" by Government of Maharashtra, and many more.



We honored her on her 1st Death Anniversary on 24th July 2014 by organizing number of programmes like the memorial stone was unveiled which was installed in Manavlok's Head Office Campus, painting competition conducted by Manavlok's Arts Center, published a book "Manaswini- Dr. Shiala Lohiya's Athawanincha Samrutigandha" which is about late Dr. Shiala Lohiya's contribution for society. The book was released by Dr. Jaganath Wani (Maharashtra Foundation-USA). Some of the dignitaries are like Mrs. Sulabhatai Bhangaokar (Social Worker, Dhule), Mrs. Anuradha Bhosale, Dr. Hemalata Patil, Lohiya's family members and relatives, and Manavlok's well-wishers. Numbers of her friends and well-wishers shared about her humanness and expressed words of missing love and support without her. The programme was concluded with the loving song presented by her Grand-Daughter Ms. Ishita Lohiya.

National Conference on "Strong Water Policy for Sustainable Rural Development"

A two days National Conference on "Strong Water Policy for Sustainable Rural Development" was held on 27th



and 28th August 2014, organized in collaboration with Manavlok, Gandhi Research Foundation, Jain Irrigation System Limited and AFARM. This national conference had aim to bring strong policy and law of water for free scarcity of drinking water and sufficient water for agricultures activities. 
